Result of Analysis of Alumni's Feedback Regarding Design, Structure, Review and Resources of Curriculum (2019-20)

We are collecting feedback from our alumni personally. We have designed a special feedback form regarding to the curriculum, course outcomes and other important aspects. We are also collecting feedback from alumni on course contents, teaching learning process and evaluation system. It is the tradition of the college to involve alumni in college activities. We believe that alumni feedback is an important source of information for betterment and development of the college.

Methodology

The feedback from students on design and review of curriculum was obtained through Structured Questionnaire which included 12 questions on various aspects of curriculum. A five point Likert scale has been used with weights assigned from 1 to 5 to different levels as follows:

1. Strongly Disagree

- 2. Disagree
- 3. Neutral
- 4. Agree
- 5. Strongly Disagree

The Range of each order or level is determined by the following formula: (Highest point in Likert Scale- Lowest point in Likert Scale)/ Number of levels used

Therefore, Range= (5-1)/5=4/5=0.8Hence,Range for 'Strongly Disagree' is1.0 to 1.8Range for 'Disagree' is1.8 to 2.6Range for 'Neutral' is2.6 to 3.4Range for 'Agree' is3.4 to 4.2Range for 'Strongly Agree' is4.2 to 5.0






















