Intellectual Property and Cultural Heritage of Meerut in the Digital World

28 January 2020

**Objective** – \* The students would be able to know about Intellectual Property Right which is part of national drive and how to register themselves for patent their goods

\*The students would enlist Meerut's goods which might be patent in future.

A one-day workshop was organized in B.Ed. department of Ismail National Mahila PG College Meerut. The topic of workshop was "Intellectual Property and Cultural Heritage of Meerut in the

**Digital World**". At the beginning of the programme Dr. Vandana Bharadwaj welcomed Dr. Sudhir Gupta (Head and Dean of Commerce, D.N.P.G. College, Meerut) by giving a bouquet of flowers.

After that, programme co-ordinator Dr. Sarika Sharma introduces the topic and explained the meaning of Intellectual Property Right. She also threw light on its types as-patent, copyright, trademark, plant variety right, geographical indication and trade secret etc. Dr Sarika Sharma also talked about Gurtej Singh Sandhu who has patented his products most in India. He has 1340 Micron Technology patented product. She also mentions Hridayeshwar Singh Bhati youngest patent (chess) holder of world. 26 April is celebrated as World Intellectual Property Day and its theme for the year 2022 is "IP and Youth Innovating for a Better Future". Resource Person Dr Sudhir Gupta cleared Start up policy which also comes under IPR. He highlighted rights and rules related to Intellectual Property. He also taught how to register online for patenting procedure and practicised students for mock online registration on mobile phones. Under Geographical Indication task he said students to prepare a list of Meerut's famous products which might be patent in future. All the students enlisted total 10 products which were 1-Yazdan scissor, 2-cricket bat, 3-cricket ball, 4-sportswear, 5-gazak, 6-musical instrument,7-handloom, 8-pearl jewellery, 9- gold and silver jewellery, 10-nan khatai etc.

IQAC Co-ordinator Dr. Deepti Kaushik was present in this workshop, she motivated students for innovative work. Following lecture series College Vice Principal, Dr. Huma Masood also presented her speech. The programme was concluding with the vote of thanks of Dr Sarika Sharma. On this occasion 15 teachers of different department, 14 students of B.Ed. 2-year session 2019-2020 and 21 students of B.Ed.1year session 2019-2020 total 50 participants were present. At the end of the programme all participants filled feedback forms and told this workshop useful as well as interesting too. Some students reported that they heard Intellectual Property right word first time and they were happy to learn new concept. Dr Sarika Sharma assured them to organise such type of workshops in future for enhancing their knowledge.

**Achieved Outcomes**- Total 35 students along with 15 teachers took active part in mock registration activity and in preparing list of products, in this way 35 students were benefitted.



**Objective of the Seminar-** To spread awareness about Intellectual Property Right among students and teachers.

On 23 November 2020 a one-day seminar was organized in Ram Lall Hall of Ismail National Mahila P.G. College MRT. The topic of seminar was 'Intellectual Property Right and Higher Education in India. Seminar was started with lighting lamp and worshiping Goddess Saraswati Ji by keynote speakers and Dr Parul Rastogi, Dr Mamta Singh and Dr Mani Bharadwaj and Chief Proctor Dr Huma Masood. Dr Sarika Sharma introduced all the three key note speakers and welcomed by giving them bouquet.

#### **Session I-**

After that, seminar organizer Dr Sarika Sharma explained intellectual property right and its importance for teachers and students. She said intellectual property allows people to own their creativity and innovation in the same way that they can own physical property. It is balance between the creator's ownership and controlling over her/his work with public access.

Dr Parul Rastogi elaborated that IPR are legal rights aimed at protecting the creations of the intellect, such as inventions, the appearance of products, literary artistic and scientific works and signs among others.

Dr Mamta Singh Head Department of Economics threw light on Trademark.

Trademark is a size capable of distinguishing the goods or services of one enterprise from those of other enterprises. Trademark date back to ancient times when artisans used to put their signature or mark on their products.

Dr Mani Bharadwaj Head Department of Commerce elucidated expansion of IPR in the digital world. She said that the protection of IPR became more important along with the expansion of world-wide information technology and digital networking in the recent years, with the tangible property bases. The rapid growth of intangible property and expansion of digital platforms providing speedy exchange of knowledge and information across the world.


#### **Session II-**
