


NSS Unit Second One Day Camp Report





The program was coordinated and conducted by Suman Mishra.



Tree plantation work was done by volunteers in the second session of the camp.


The program was conducted and coordinated by Suman Mishra.

In the second session of the camp, a rally was taken out with a slogan on the topic of water conservation. Suman Mishra conducted and coordinated the program.





Suman Mishra conducted and coordinated the program.
