



### **Report of International Symposium**

### **Date-31 August 2021**

Dr Renu Agrawal HOD of Chemistry Department organized an International Symposium under Mission Shakti scheme of government. The objective of this programme was to encourage women for financial independency. Topic of this programme was "Entrepreneurship Development among Women"

Dr Renu Agrawal said that entrepreneurship development is the process of enhancing the entrepreneurial knowledge and skills via structured training programmes.
