Technical Session Report

First Technical Session: Fiscal Consolidation and Macroeconomic Challenges

This technical session started with the speech of Prof. Atvir singh, head Department of Economics, Chaudhary Charan Singh University, Meerut. He started his lecture by highlighting the importance of budget in economy and government policy making. This lecture was focused on the declining health and education expenditure and its long term implications on fiscal consolidation in economy. This may jeopardise the economic growth sustainability in future. He also recommended to increase allocations to both sectors. Prof. Singh also highlighted the importance of giving tax rebated to the super rich in India. This may help setting and rebound of MSMEs in economy. This may be generating more revenue to government and subsequent fiscal consolidation. The rising inequalities and declining social sector expenditure is found to be a new challenge to Indian economy. The 85 students have attended the session.





Second Technical Session: Capital Expenditure and Issues Involved

In the second session the lecture was delivered by Dr. Raviraj Singh, Department of Economics, Chaudhary Charan Singh University, Meerut. He focussed on the increased capital expenditure in the budget 2023-24. He highlighted the importance of capital expenditure in economic growth of the country. But the execution of amounted capital expenditure is hydra headed and a difficult task. The lecturer said the government has limited absorption capacity of amounted expenditure. This was said that it will be a new challenge for achieving 10.5 percent nominal GDP growth rate targeted in Budget 2023-24. He also highlighted the accounting reallocation in the budget with special reference to MGNREGA and fertiliser subsidy allocation. The 85 students have attended the session.



Third Technical Session: Defence Budget in Emerging Threats Involved

The third technical session was delivered by Dinesh Kumar (UGC-JRF, Doctoral Fellow). He started his lecture by introducing the importance of defence expenditure in budget. He highlighted the challenges emerging out of increasing current expenditure under defence allocations. The lecturer recommended an increase in capital expenditure component amid the rising global strategic uncertainties. Kumar recommended to reduce the current expenditure.

Union Budget 2023-24 and Possibilities of Amrit Kaal

Abstract

Union Budget 2023-24 was presented with the vision of Amrit Kaal, which includes technology dependent and knowledge intensive economy. This all depend on sound public finances, and strong financial sector. The fundamentals of public and financial sector depend on Jan Bhagidari, which rests on Sabka Sath Sabka Parayas. The present paper examines the viability of these variable in ensuring the vison of Amrit Kaal. This paper rests on the macroeconomic policy statement presented in the parliament. The findings show that fiscal and financial variables are moving in the direction of achieving the vision of Amrit Kaal.

Union Budget 2023-24's Increase in Capital Expenditure and Prospects for Growth

Abstract

The proposed 33 percent increase in capital expenditure was accepted by media and policy makers with flowers. The present paper examines the viability of improvement in capital expenditure and its impact on the economic growth of the India. The past two years' budget has also been analysed. The paper found that the improvement in capital expenditure depends on the expenditure cuts from the MGNREGA, and food security schemes operated by the government. The preconditions of states loan to be provided by the central government has its own limitations. This compromises the growth potential in the Indian economy. The expenditure on MGNREGA and food security may be increased if the economic conditions. This compromises the potential of increase in capital expenditure.

Health Sector Union Budget 2023-24

In Union Budget 2023-24, Finance Minister (FM) announced 157 nursing colleges in conformity with the existing 157 medical colleges established since 2014. The FM said that a Mission to eliminate Sickle Cell Anaemia will be launched to eliminate it by 2047, this has to cover almost 7 crore people in the age group 0-40 years. The facilities in select ICMR Labs will be made available for research by public and private medical college faculty and private sector R&D teams for encouraging collaborative research and innovation. The present paper analysed the viability of these initiatives in the health sector. The study found that the success of these schemes depends on the financial allocation to be made in budget.

Green Growth Promises in Union Budget 2023-24

Abstract

Prime Minister of India has given a vision for "LiFE" (Lifestyle for Environment) to spur a movement of environmentally conscious lifestyle. India is moving forward firmly for the 'panchamrit' and net-zero carbon emission by 2070. This was to usher the green industrial and economic transition. The recently launched National Green Hydrogen Mission, with an outlay of Rs 19,700 crores, will facilitate transition of the economy to low carbon intensity, reduce dependence on fossil fuel imports, and make the country assume technology and market leadership in this sunrise sector. The Budget also provides Rs35,000 crore for priority capital investments towards energy transition and net zero objectives, and energy security by Ministry of Petroleum & Natural Gas. The present paper analysed the direction adopted in achieving green growth objectives. The paper found the direction is good but we have to go far in achieving these climates associated goals.

Direct Tax Reforms in Union Budget 2023-24

To further improve tax payer services, proposal to roll out a next-generation Common IT Return Form for tax payer convenience, along with plans to strengthen the grievance redressal mechanism. Rebate limit of Personal Income Tax to be increased to Rs. 7 lakh from the current Rs. 5 lakh in the new tax regime. This paper examines the direct tax provisions made in union budget 2023-24. The present paper analysed the performance of global economic slowdown resulting from the Ukraine conflict and continued effects of the pandemic, the Indian economy has been recognised as a 'Bright Star' by the world with an estimated growth rate of 7% in the current year - notably the highest among the major world economies. Budget 2023 lays the foundation for the Prime Minister's vision of India@100 by adopting seven priorities, namely, Inclusive Development, Reaching the Last Mile, Infrastructure and Investment, Unleashing the Potential, Green Growth, Youth Power and Financial Sector. The focus continues to be on increasing the capital investment outlay to enhance growth potential and job creation. Several policy reforms have been introduced relating to the overall economic sustainability, agricultural automation, integrated digitisation (including focus on AI excellence and simplification of the KYC process), start-up ecosystem and certain priority sectors such as Green Growth. 
